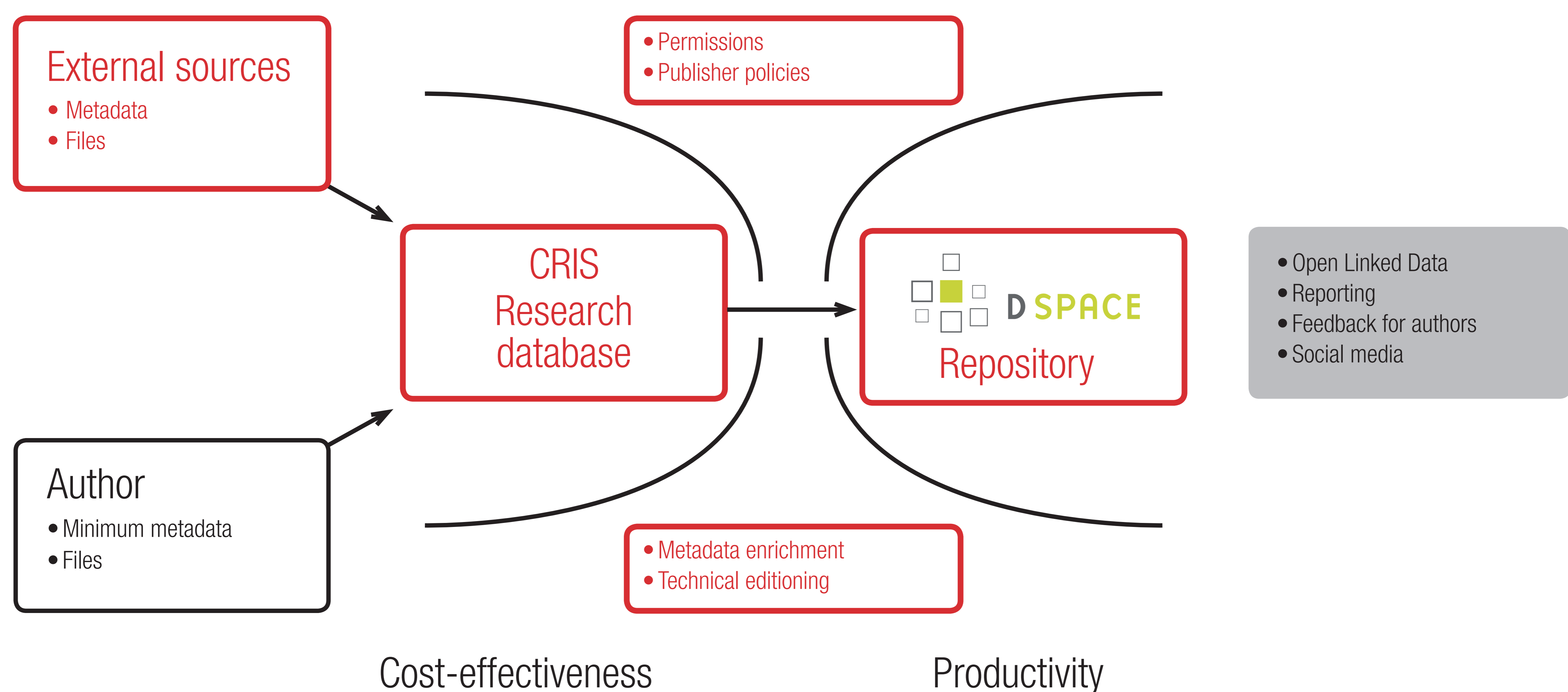

## Finland – a model country for Green Open Access

A joint project by University of Jyväskylä and University of Eastern Finland. Funded by the Ministry of Education and Culture. Project integrates CRIS, IR and external metadata sources into one comprehensive, cost effective and general model for Green Open Access. The participating universities will test and implement the created model and raise the awareness of Open Access during the project. The aim of the project is to lift the Green Open Access activity in Finland to international top level. Results of the project will be published in several research and conference papers.

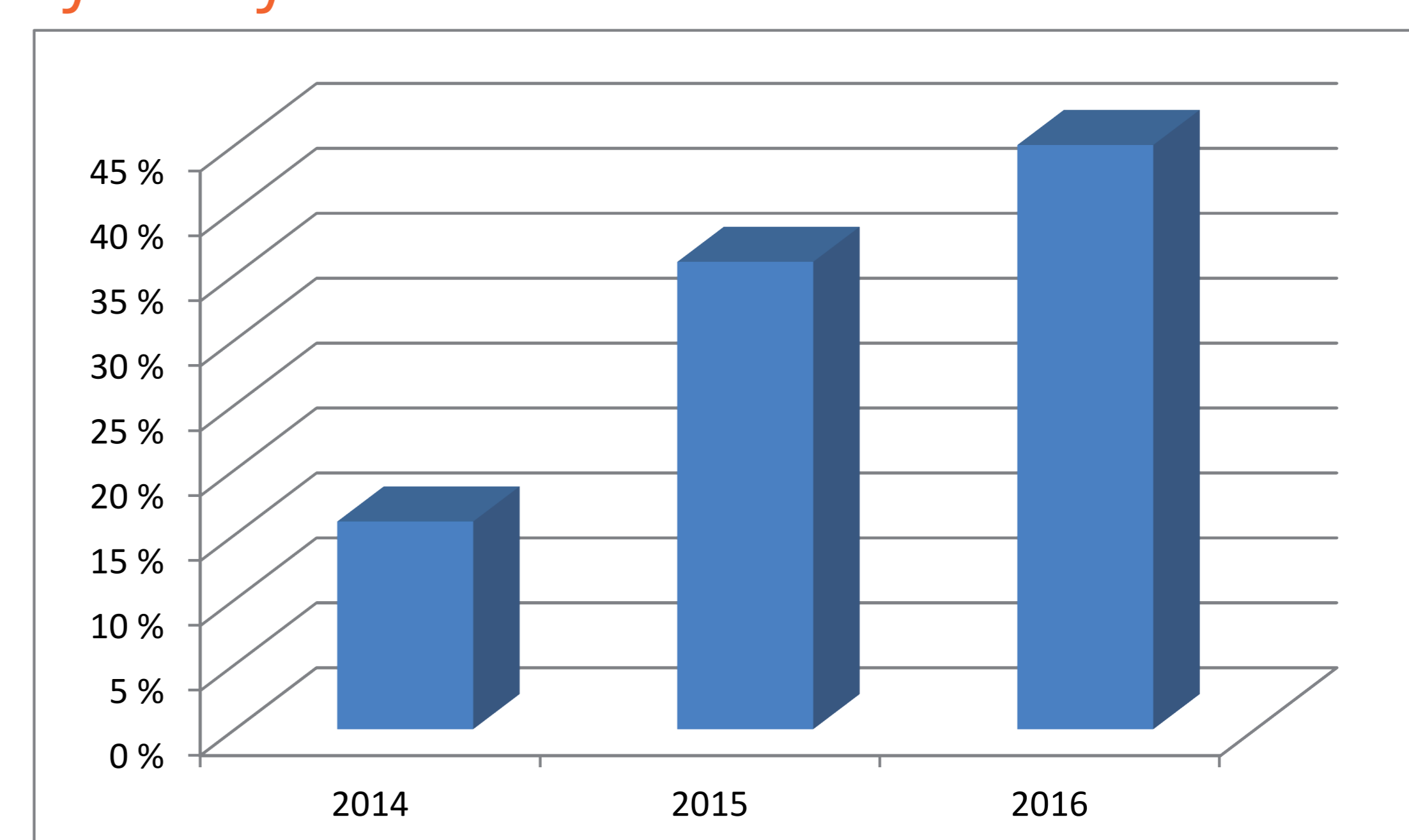
No extra work for researchers, **university library** is the key player
